GREETINGS !

Morris will celebrate its 24th Annual Prairie Pioneer Days Festival July 11th through July 13th, 2007. Thank you for registering to have a unit in our parade on Sunday, July 13th. The parade will begin promptly at 3:00 p.m. The Prairie Pioneer Days Grand Parade is the highlight of a weekend of traditional fun.

We will again have the registration table set up at the Salvation Army parking lot located at the corner of College Avenue and East 7th Street. ALL UNITS MUST CHECK IN between 12:00- 2:00p.m, Sunday, July 14th, AT THIS BOOTH. This is where your unit number will be assigned to you. You must be LINED UP AND READY TO START by 2:30 p.m. The parade will start promptly at 3:00 p.m. The parade route will proceed down 7th Street turning on California Avenue, down to 2nd Street and conclude at the refreshment stand on 2nd street.

For the safety of all spectators, we request that candy or fliers not be thrown from the parade units. You may have walkers along side your float for this purpose.

Go-carts or other ATV's or small units may not perform any exhibition driving without clearing it in advance through the Chamber. Because many children attend the parade, and sometimes dart out to receive candy, we ask that all go-carts and small vehicles drive down the center of the street just as the larger units do. This is to prevent accidents.

Parking for additional vehicles that tow or carry floats to the parade may be found at the Best Northland Prairie Inn, Pamida (please park on the edges of the the Prairie Inn and Pamida lots) and the old elementary school lot on Columbia.
