

Rural Recycling

Stevens County rural residents may deposit recyclables in a transportable recycling trailer at these locations on the dates specified:

- **ALBERTA:** 1st Saturday and Sunday of the month-Located South of the Cargill Elevator
- **CHOKIO:** 2nd Saturday and Sunday of the month-Located at the County Garage on Hwy 28
- **DONNELLY:** 3rd Saturday and Sunday of the month-Located just off of Hwy 9 South of the City Park
- **HANCOCK:** 4th Saturday and Sunday of the month-Located next to the old Laundromat
- **MORRIS:** 3rd and 4th Tuesday of the month-Located at City Garage or at Engebretson Sanitary, Disposal, and Recycling Service Hwy 9 South M-F 8-4, Saturdays till Noon

Recycling Trailers

These items can be accepted at the recycling trailers:

- **NEWSPAPER ONLY:** No glossy finish papers like catalogs or notebooks
- **ALUMINUM CANS:** Crush if possible. Rinse and Remove any paper labels
- **TIN CANS:** Rinse and Remove any paper labels. Crush if possible
- **GLASS:** Clean Clear, Brown, or Green Bottles or Jars. Remove labels and caps. Do not break the glass when depositing into the trailer.
No light bulbs, ceramics, or flowerpots. No household glassware or caps.
- **PLASTIC:** PETE#1 or HDPE#2. Rinse, Flatten, and remove caps/labels.
