



Thank you for registering to attend the 26th Annual Prairie Pioneer Days Festival! Vendor hours at East Side Park ( East 7th Street, two blocks off of Atlantic Avenue) will be Saturday, July 10 from 9-5:00, and Sunday, July 11 from 11-5:00. We encourage food vendors to be open later Saturday to take advantage of the Family Feud game that will take place at 5:00 in the Band Shell.

Set up times are from **6:00-9:00 am on Saturday**, and **8:00-11:00 am on Sunday**. **Nothing can be moved into the park prior to 6 a.m. Saturday morning.** Enclosed is a parking permit that you may use for unloading only. The city police will ticket any vehicle parked in the no parking zone. We ask that you unload your vehicle as quickly as possible, and then move it as far away from the park as possible in order to leave parking spaces for customers.

All vendor spots are assigned, and Sandy will be available at the Information Booth (under the maroon canopy) to help you find your area.

Please stop by the Information Booth for a morning treat on Saturday and Sunday morning.

**Vendors do not need to wait in line at the food booths.** Please walk to the front of the booth and inform the workers that you are a vendor, and you will be helped immediately. If you are alone, and unable to leave your booth, one of our volunteers would be happy to relieve you, or bring lunch to you. Just let the Information Booth know when you register, and someone will help you.

We do not recommend that you leave your craft/vendor items in the park overnight. While police will patrol regularly, we are not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Camping is not allowed at East Side Park, but Pomme de Terre Park has facilities available, and it is a beautiful area. Morris Super 8 (589-8888) and the Best Northland Prairie Inn (589-1005) also offer accommodations for our out of town vendors.
