

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING IN STEVENS COUNTY

--CURBSIDE COLLECTION--

RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

- ▶ Use your blue recycling bin
- ▶ Place recyclables in paper grocery bags or softener salt bags
- ▶ Recycle only the following sorted materials:

Newspaper Only: No glossy finish papers, catalogs/magazines, or phone books. Bundle with twine or put in paper grocery bag.

Aluminum Cans: Crush if possible to save space.

Tin Cans: Rinse and remove paper labels.

Glass Bottles & Jars: Clean clear, brown or green bottles and jars. Remove all caps and lids. Do not break. ***NO LIGHT BULBS, MIRRORS, WINDOW GLASS OR CERAMICS.***

Plastic: Only #1 or #2 small neck bottles; caps removed. Check the bottom of container for recycling symbols and number. Wide mouth plastic containers are not accepted if the mouth is wider than the base of the container (e.g. ice cream pails, cool whip containers, margarine tubs, etc.).

Note:

- ▶ All containers must be decapped. Caps can go in the garbage.
- ▶ Although cardboard is not collected at curbside or in the rural recycling trailers, it can be brought for recycling to Engebretson Disposal and Recycling at 23780 470th Ave. South of Morris.

- ▶ Morris Westside – 1st Friday of month
- ▶ Chokio & Alberta – 2nd Thursday of month
- ▶ Hancock & Donnelly – 2nd Friday of month

RURAL RECYCLING IN STEVENS COUNTY

--RECYCLING TRAILERS--

Rural residents can drop-off recyclables at a transportable recycling trailer located monthly at a city nearest them. The same instructions apply in preparing recycling materials as the curbside program on the other side of this guide. A recycling trailer will be located in the following towns and locations on the days specified below:

- ▶ Alberta: 1st weekend of the month – South of Cargill Elevator
- ▶ Chokio: 2nd weekend of the month – County Hwy. Garage on Hwy 28
- ▶ Donnelly: 3rd weekend of the month – South of City Park
- ▶ Hancock: 4th weekend of the month – Next to old Laundromat
- ▶ Morris: 3rd & 4th Tuesday of the month – Lee Community Center Lot
- ▶ Morris City Garage: Recycling trailer parked for daily recycling.

IMPORTANT GLASS RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

You can only recycle glass food and beverage bottles and jars. Glass recycling manufacturers reject truckloads of glass because they contain non-recyclable materials such as ceramics, plate glass, drinking glasses, window glass and white bottles that look like ceramics. These glass materials cannot be recycled because they melt at different temperatures and produce glass food and beverage containers with bumpy or sharp surfaces. These non-recyclable glass products can be discarded into your daily garbage. Glass is a part of the Stevens County recycling program. Please do your part and recycle only the acceptable glass products. Remember, it only takes a chip of ceramic the size of a marble or other non-recyclable glass to reject a load.
